### Age Appropriate Homework Expectations

<b>Phonics Expectations</b>	Children should practice segmenting and blending words in the environment with sounds they have been taught and continue to orally segment words to hear the phonemes within the word for a minimum of 10 minutes per day. This can be spread throughout the day.
<b>Reading Expectations:</b>	Read for 10 minutes each day and write in your Reading Record. Children should read their Phonics book each day. Other reading can include a mix of reading to your child(ren) and them telling you a story using pictures. Rereading books is highly encouraged.
<b>Maths Expectations:</b>	For 10 minutes per day.

*Dedicating time each day to homework & helps you to form effective learning habits.*

### Topic Tasks

Please pick a different activity to **do with your family each week**. Completing your homework with your family should be a positive experience, the discussion & fun you have is just as important as the outcome. Enjoy!

There is no right or wrong way to complete the task. Take as long, or as little, time as you like on these tasks. A large project may take a number of weeks.

Bring Topic Tasks to school in any way you like: Tapestry, email, photo, written, scrap book, artwork, edible... You can send any photos that you take to the class teacher or print them out to show the class.

Draw picture of planets <i>PD/PSED/C&amp;L/EAD</i>	Read a book and then talk about what happened without using the pictures <i>C&amp;L/Lit</i>	Visit a library. Can you find any books about Space? <i>Lit/PSED</i>
Use empty containers, water and small parts from around your home to explore capacity and mass <i>Maths</i>	Create a calendar for the week or month-discuss the dates and days of the week. <i>Maths</i>	Look at pictures of the planets. What do you notice about them. What is similar/different. <i>PSED/C&amp;L/UtW</i>
Look out of the window at night and talk about what you can see in the sky <i>UtW/C&amp;L</i>	Write your own Moon Diary <i>PSED/Lit/PD</i>	Thread pipe cleaners (or ribbon/wool) through the holes in a colander to make an alien hat <i>PD/PSED</i>
Design your own Space craft or space creature and label using your phonics <i>PSED/Lit/C&amp;L</i>	Act out our favourite scene from a book or show <i>PSED/C&amp;L</i>	Play a board game with your family/friends. <i>PSED</i>

Any additional learning may be sent home as appropriate.
